## 1. Introduction

Prospectus for admission to B.Tech. Degree Programs for Working Professionals for the academic year 2024-25, which has been approved by the Government of Kerala, is published herewith. It contains the general information and rules relating to the admission to the B.Tech. Degree Programs for Working Professionals for the academic year 2024-25, and other connected matters. Candidates are required to go through the prospectus carefully and acquaint themselves with all the relevant information. Candidates are also requested to visit the following websites regularly for notifications and announcements – <https://www.dtekerala.gov.in>, <https://ktu.edu.in>, <https://www.cet.ac.in>.

B.Tech. Degree Courses for Working Professionals are offered in selected Engineering Colleges of the State for students possessing Diploma/B.Sc. Degree to acquire Bachelor Degree in Engineering. The course extends over a period of three academic years. The classes will be conducted normally in the evenings on all working days and Saturdays (including Second Saturdays) and on holidays, if necessary, in accordance with the syllabi of the APJ Abdul Kalam Technological University. The prospectus issued during the previous years are not valid for the year 2024-25. The English version of the prospectus shall only be considered as authentic, in the case of dispute in any of the clauses of the Prospectus for admission to B.Tech. Degree Programs for working professionals for the academic year 2024-25. This Prospectus sets out the rules & regulations for selection and admission to the B.Tech. Degree Programs for Working Professionals for the academic year 2024-25 by the Director of Technical Education within the State of Kerala.

Admission to the B.Tech. Degree Programs for working professionals for the academic year 2024-25 are regulated on the basis of merit as assessed in the rank list prepared based on the details given in Clause 10.

This Prospectus is subject to modification/addition/deletion, as may be deemed necessary by the Government of Kerala.

## 2. Institutions ,Programs ,Number of Seats and Duration

The list of institutions, programs offered and the total numbers of seats available in each program (branch) is given in **ANNEXURE A** (final list will be published later in the website <https://ktu.edu.in>).

The duration of the program is same as that of Lateral Entry to Second Year with a total duration NOT less than THREE years (6 Semesters) and shall fulfill the total contact hours as prescribed by the APJ Abdul Kalam Technological University, Thiruvananthapuram and will include Lectures, Laboratory works, Seminars, Project work and Thesis. The hours of work will be from 5.45pm to 9.15 pm, normally 6 days a week/ any flexible convenient timings (including weekends/holidays).

Mode of conduct of classes shall be in the form of regular programs as defined in the Public Notice F.No.AICTE/AB/Academic/2020-21, dated.13/08/2020.

## 3. Fee Structure

Admission Fee :	Rs. 1500/- (to be paid at the time of admission)
Tuition Fee :	Rs. 31000/- (per Semester)
Special Fee :	Rs. 3150/- (per year)
Caution Deposit :	Rs. 2500/- (to be paid at the time of admission) (refundable)
Pre-Matriculation & Registration Fee :	as prescribed by the University

Note: Fee concession is not allowed to State & Central Government Employees who belong to the category of SC/ST/OEC//SEBC as per Government letter from SC/ST Department(A), (No.917/A2/2015/SCSTDD, Thiruvananthapuram dated 31/07/2017). However, those who are availing LWA for higher studies are eligible for fee concession under special conditions as per G.O(Ms)No.20/2022/SCTD dated 08/04/2022.

## 4. Eligibility for Admission

The candidate seeking admission to the Program should be a Professional/Employee working in Registered Industry / Organization (Central / State) / Private/ Public Limited Company/ MSMEs located within 75 km radial distance from the Institute. In proof thereof the candidate shall submit proof of employment from the employer in the form of an employment certificate, the format of which is given in **ANNEXURE B**.

The candidate should have been employed in the Registered Industry / Organization (Central / State) / Private/ Public Limited Company/ MSMEs for a minimum continuous period of ONE Year on Full time / Regular basis. In proof thereof the candidate shall submit proof of continuous employment and conduct from the employer in the format given in **ANNEXURE C**.

There shall be no age limit to apply for admission to the program.

Qualification of the candidate should be the same as that of candidates eligible for Lateral Entry to Second Year (As Specified in Approval Process Handbook published by AICTE from time to time). The candidate should have passed

- a. Diploma in ANY branch of Engineering /Technology awarded by a recognized State Board of Technical Education or equivalent with at least 45% of marks (40% marks in the case of candidates belonging to reserved categories)

OR

- b. B.Sc. Degree from a recognized University as defined by UGC with at least 45% of marks (40% marks in the case of candidates belonging to reserved categories) and passed 10+2 examination with Mathematics as a subject, provided that the candidates belonging to B.Sc. stream shall study the courses Engineering Graphics/Drawing & Engineering Mechanics of the First Year Engineering Program along with the Second Year Courses. These courses can be taken as audit courses.

OR

- c. D.Voc. Stream in the same or allied sector.

**Note:-**In the absence of eligible candidates with minimum one year experience after acquiring diploma as on 01<sup>st</sup>AUGUST 2024, application from those who are having less than one year may also be considered. A separate supplementary rank list will be published for them and the admission from that rank list will be considered only after the admission of professionally eligible candidates.

## **5. Academic Requirements**

- 1) Total credits as specified in the curriculum of APJ Abdul Kalam Technological University for the B.Tech.(WP) program are required to be earned for getting the degree.
- 2) Syllabus shall be same as applicable to regular students.
- 3) As per the AICTE file No.AICTE/P & AP/APH/2023-24/01, dated 24/08/2023, up to 40% of credit transfer is permitted through MOOCs / SWAYAM.
- 4) Examination shall be the same as that of the regular students.

## **6. Reservation of Seats**

Out of the total seats available for the various courses, seats will be reserved for different categories as given herewith.

### **A. Reservation for Persons with Disabilities**

Five percent of the seats available for allotment from the rank lists, for all the programs in all the Government Colleges are reserved for the candidates with disabilities. 5% seats are reserved for physically disabled. Candidates claiming reservation under physically disabled quota shall have a minimum of 40% disability. A disability certificate from the District Medical Board has to be attached along with the application. Such candidates are also required to produce a certificate obtained from the Medical Officer not below the rank of an Assistant Surgeon to the effect that the candidate is fit enough to undergo the course, having more than 40% disability. In case no qualified candidates are available under PD Category, the seats will go to General Merit.

### **B. Reservation for Transgender Candidates**

One seat shall be reserved for Transgender candidates. In the absence of eligible candidates under this quota, the seat will fall into General Merit category. Eligible

- candidates should submit Transgender ID Card/Proof issued by the State Government and admitting authority should verify the same at the time of admission.

### C. Special Reservation

- Within the sanctioned seats in each institution, one seat is reserved for candidate under sports quota. Candidates who claim reservation under sports quota must attach a certificate of eligibility issued by the Kerala Sports Council as per the guidelines published by them along with the application for selection under this quota. In the absence of eligible candidates under this quota, the seat will fall into General Merit category.
- Within the sanctioned strength in each institution, one seat in each branch is reserved for the staff of the Department of Technical Education. Selection will be based on their length of professional service in the Department after acquiring the Diploma. Such applications must be sent through proper channel of the Directorate of Technical Education, Thiruvananthapuram.
- One seat shall be Reserved for Candidates working in Central Government Organizations / Industries /Companies / Autonomous Organizations purely on MERIT Basis. In absence of any such Candidates the vacant seat may be transferred to General Category.

### D. Mandatory Reservation

The remaining seats will be distributed as per the mandatory reservation principle as contemplated in G.O. (P) 208/66/Edn. Dated 2.5.1966, G.O. (MS) No. 95/08/SCSTDD dated 06/10/2008, G.O (MS) No. 10/2014/BCDD dated 23/05/2014, G.O (MS) No. 128/2020/H.Edn dated 20.3.2020 and as modified from time to time. The percentage break-up of seats as per mandatory reservation is as follows:

- d) The seats unavailed by the ST candidates will be allotted to SC candidates and viceversa. The seats unavailed by SC/ST candidates will be allotted to candidates belonging to the Other Eligible Communities.
- e) The seats unavailed in any reservation quota will go to general merit, without prejudice to clause d) above.
- f) As per the G.O.(MS) No. 128/2020/ HEDN dated. 20.01.2020. Government have decided to implement reservation for Economically Weaker Sections in general category (EWS) to all Higher Educational Institutions. .
- g) The seats that still remain un-availed will go to the State Merit Quota.
- h) The seats un-availed by the SEBC category candidates will be allotted under State Merit in the final allotment in the stream.
- i) If any seat, in any special reservation quota, is left un-availed by the candidates belonging to that particular category, those seats will go to the Mandatory reservation quota unless otherwise stated.

## **7. Claim for the Reservation and Certificates to be produced**

- a) The seats under the State Merit (SM) will be filled purely on merit basis irrespective of the category/community to which the candidates belong.
- b) Claims for Special/Mandatory reservations must be made by a candidate in the application and the supporting documents shall be attached within the stipulated time. The claim has to be specified in the application in the respective places. Claims made



- after the last date of submission of application will not be entertained even if supporting evidences are produced. The claims for Special and Mandatory Reservation once made in the application cannot be altered by the candidate under any circumstances.
- c) Only candidates belonging to 'Keralite' category (as defined herewith), are eligible for claiming seats under Mandatory quota in Government Colleges. Note: Keralites: A candidate of Kerala origin will be categorized as a 'Keralite'. Children of All India Service (AIS) officers (Non-Keralites) allotted to Kerala cadre are deemed to be 'Keralites' as Per G.O. (Rt) No. 822/08/H. Edn. dated 29/05/2008. But they will not be eligible for Communal/ Special/ Persons with Disabilities or any fee concession. All other candidates from outside Kerala State are considered as General Category and reservation is not applicable.
  - d) Candidates should mention the item of reservation claimed in the relevant columns in the application.
  - e) Candidates should attach along with their application, relevant Certificates as mentioned for each item, in support of the claim.
  - f) Candidates belonging to SEBC (as per G.O.(P)208/66/Edn.dated.02/05/1966,G.O. (Ms) No. 95/08/SCSTDD dated 06/10/2008 and as amended from time to time) and whose annual family income (i.e. Annual income of all members in the family, including the candidate, from all sources taken together) is up to **Rs. 8 lakhs (Rupees Eight Lakhs only)** are eligible for reservation under this category (for salaried persons DA should also be taken while computing total income). (G.O(Ms)No.03/2018,tsCDD dated 09/04/2018).
  - g) Candidates claiming reservation under SEBC quota should invariably produce Non-creamy layer Certificate obtained issued within one year from the Village Officer concerned.
  - h) Candidates claiming reservation under SC/ST quota need to produce Caste/ Community Certificates issued within three years from the Tahasildar or front page of SSLC Book showing such details.
  - i) To avail reservation for Economically Weaker Sections in general category (EWS) the candidates should upload necessary certificates from concerned Village officer. The annual family income for EWS category candidates shall not exceed Rs.4 lakh (Rupees

Four Lakh) as per G.O. (Ms) No. 2/2020/P&ARD dated 12.02.2020. There is no income limit to those EWS candidates belonging to Anthyodaya/Annayojana and Priority House Hold.

## 8. Application Fees

Applicants can pay the fees online (internet banking/UPI payments/Credit or Debit card transaction) while submitting their applications. Application form number has to be specified for online fee payment. The Fee receipt has to be attached along with the application. Application fees Rs.800/- and Rs.400/- in the case of SC/ST Candidates. The details of the same will be made available in the website <https://www.dtekerala.gov.in>; <https://www.cet.ac.in>.

## 9. Submission of Applications

The time schedule is given in ANNEXURE H. The documents to be uploaded include:

- a) Diploma/B.Sc. Degree Certificate
- b) Mark List of Diploma/B.Sc. Degree Examination. In the case of semester system, the mark lists of all semesters should be attached. The copy of Diploma/B.Sc. Degree Mark List must contain both sides of the original Mark List.
- c) Non-Creamy Layer Certificate for SEBC Candidates issued within one year from the Village Officer concerned and Community Certificate for SC/ST candidates issued within three years from the Tahasildar or front page of SSLC Book showing such details.
- d) Those who claim experience as per Clauses 4 and 6Cb) and c), a **copy of the Experience Certificate as per ANNEXURE C duly attested by the Head of the Establishment should be attached.**
- e) Application defective in any respect to r which do not contain the relevant documents or those received late will summarily be rejected.

Note: No opportunity will be given to incorporate any details after the submission of the application.

## 10. Selection

- a) The candidates shall qualify the Entrance Test conducted by the LBS Centre for Science & Technology, Thiruvananthapuram, for the lateral entry students for B.Tech. regular admissions as given by the APJ Abdul Kalam Technological University U.O. No.3049/2023/KTU,Thiruvananthapuram, dated 22/11/2023 (file Ref. No.KTU/ASST7(ACADEMIC)/5062/2023). Based on the marks obtained in the Entrance Test selection will be carried out provided the eligibility criteria as per Clause 4 is met with.
- b) The admission will be made on the basis of merit and reservation as applicable in the case of admission to regular B.Tech. programs.
- c) A rank list of candidates will be prepared for the admission based on the CGPA(on a scale of 10) scored in the Diploma/B.Sc. Degree program.
- d) For the cases where the CGPA is not in the scale of 10, the CGPA value shall be normalized to the scale of 10 as follows:  $CGPA \text{ (on 10 scale)} = 10 \times CGPA / S$ , where S is the scale on which the CGPA was awarded.
- e) In the case of candidates having mark lists that show only the percentage of marks, the CGPA will be derived as  $CGPA = \text{percentage marks} / 10$ .
- f) Candidates with B.Sc. Degree will be considered only in the absence of Diploma holders.
- g) In the case of tie in the marks, the work experience of the candidate will be taken into account and the candidate with more experience will be placed higher in the ranking.
- h) In the case of further tie, the age of the candidate will be taken into account and the older will be placed higher in the ranking.
- i) Further in the case of tie, candidate with higher rank in the qualifying entrance test will be ranked higher.
- j) If any seats are vacant after the last round, candidates from other States/UTs may also be considered for admission, if they reside within a 50 km radial distance from the institute.
- k) In the absence of eligible candidates as described in Clause 4 and after allotment after described above, applicants who have not qualified the entrance test may be considered after preparing a supplementary list on the merit basis.

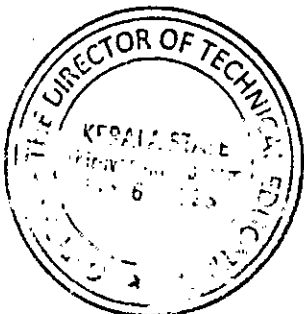
- l) The procedure for preparation of rank list mentioned herewith is liable to change from time to time based on the directions from APJ Abdul Kalam Technological University and Government of Kerala.

## 11. Allotment to the Institution

- a) Allotment to Institution will be done based on the rank. The rank list will be published on the website <https://www.dtekerala.gov.in> and <https://lbscentre.in/>.
- b) If a candidate is not joining in an Institution as per the allotment, his further claim for admission will be automatically cancelled.
- c) Selected candidates shall produce a No Objection Certificate from the Head of the office / Establishment in the format given in ANNEXURE I at the time of joining.
- d) The admission work is entrusted to LBS Centre for Science and Technology, Thiruvananthapuram.

## 12. Cancellation of Courses

- a) If the number of eligible candidates opted for any branch in an institution is less than 20 numbers per branch, the course will not be conducted at that institution.
- b) Any other details not specifically covered by the clauses given will be decided by the Director of Technical Education and his decision will be final.
- c) Any admission found to be not in order subsequent to the admission will be liable for cancellation.
